The Rancho La Puente Land Grant was 48,790 acres. (1)
 39% of Rancho La Puente was identified as Hill land.
 61% of Rancho La Puente was identified as Valley land.
 Rowland and Workman each received 50% (24,395 acres) of the land.
 Rowland received 1 acre more Valley land than Workman.
 Rowland received 14,780 acres of Valley land.
 Workman received 14,779 acres of Valley land.
 Workman received 1 acre more Hill land than Rowland.
 Workman received 9,616 acres of Hill land.
 Rowland received 9,915 acres of Hill land.
